Award one point per item for accuracy and one point for ability to communicate well.

Activity 5 asks students to produce food vocabulary and talk about likes and dislikes using I like ...
I love ... I don't like ...

Number two. I love burgers.

Point to an item in the picture and name it. Point to other items and ask students to name them. Encourage them to name any flavours they see, e.g. mango juice, cherry cake, strawberry milkshake. Then point to an item, e.g. the ice cream and say Number one is chocolate ice cream. I like chocolate ice cream. Point to another picture, e.g. the cake and say Number eight is cherry cake. I don't like cherry cake. Point to another picture and encourage a student to make a sentence. Put students in pairs and ask them to take it in turns to say a number and if they love / like / don't like the item. Each student should say five items.

Activity 6 asks students to talk about food preferences using *Do you like ...?*

Do you like vanilla ice cream? No, I don't.

Ask a question to a member of the class, e.g. *Do you like mango juice?* Let them answer. Students work in pairs. Each student points to five items and asks and answers the questions. Tell them to ask about flavours, where appropriate, e.g. lemon cake, vanilla ice cream, mango juice, chocolate milkshake.
