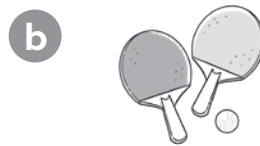

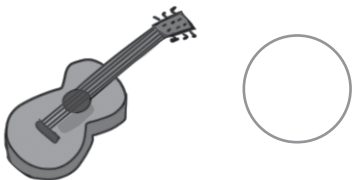

Award up to five points for accuracy and up to five points for ability to communicate well.

Activity 5 asks pupils to talk about activities they want / don't want to do.

Point to the pictures and elicit the actions from the class. Then draw pupils' attention to the days. Ask *What do you want to do on Friday? And on Saturday? And what do you want to do on Sunday?* Explain that for each day they need to choose one of the activities they want to do. They tick the activity they want to do and put a cross for the activity they don't want to do. Allow a minute or so for pupils to decide. Monitor and make sure they're putting a tick and a cross for each day.

Then do an example with a pupil. Ask him/her to show the pictures for Friday and say *On Friday, I want to (sail a boat / swim in the lake). I don't want to (swim in the lake / sail a boat)*. Put pupils in pairs. They take turns telling their partner what they want / don't want to do on the three days.

Activity 6 asks pupils to ask and answer *Do you want to ...?*

Do an example with the class. Point to the first picture and ask a pupil *Do you want to read a comic?* Prompt the pupil to answer *Yes, please* or *No, thank you*. Ask pupils to draw happy/sad faces in the circles next to the pictures to show what they want to do. Monitor and check that pupils aren't drawing all happy or all sad faces. Then put pupils in pairs. They take turns asking *Do you want to ...?* and answering *Yes, please* or *No, thank you* based on the faces they drew.
